36 students in rising grades 1-6 will be enrolled. They will be split into 3 groups based on grade levels. Each group will rotate into 3 music classes in the morning. They will attend a singing class, hand drumming/ukulele/guitar class and music movement class.

The students rotate into three enrichment classes in the afternoon.

Duties include the following:

Bus monitor for morning bus. Can board the bus @7:00 at the first stop or meet the bus at Lafayette Elem. before picking up children.

Morning meeting/Breakfast cafeteria monitor

Classroom assistant - May need to remove disruptive children from the classroom.

Lunchroom/recess monitor

Bus monitor for afternoon bus.

A background in the study of social work, related study or music preferred, but not required. Security clearances are required

This is a great opportunity to work with and mentor at risk youth. Volunteers will discover that children improve cognitive and non cognitive skills as they study music.
